RULES FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE DECLARATIONS OF COVENANTS AND

2-1-Cat

These procedures are promulgated pursuant to Section 13.2 of the Declarations and those powers granted to the Directors by the By-Laws and by the laws of the State of Florida.

- 1. Any believed violation(s) of the Rules, Regulations or the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions shall be directed to the President of the Board of Directors IN WRITING.
- 2. Any Director may bring any violation before the Board of Directors at any regular or special board meeting, which shall be equivalent to a writing.
- 3. The Board of Directors shall examine the report of the alleged violation, and shall issue a writing to the alleged violator to be mailed certified, return receipt requested in the United States and registered mail elsewhere. Said writing shall set a time and place for the alleged violator to appear before the Board of Directors. Said time of appearance shall be within ten (10) days from the date of the writing. The decision to issue a writing as to the alleged violation shall be by the majority of the members of the Board present at the meeting where the allegation of violation is presented.
- 4. If the alleged violator is a tenant or guest, then the owner of the villa shall also be notified as above provided as to set hearing.
- 5. The alleged violator shall appear at the appointed time and place to show to the Board why the alleged violation is either untrue or not a violation.
- 6. After hearing the presentation of the alleged violator, the Board shall close the session and shall render a decision as to the alleged violation, i.e., whether it is or is not a violation. Said decision shall be by a majority of the Board present.
- 7. The Board is authorized to impose the following sanction in addition to any others previously granted to the Board of Directors:
- (a) A monetary fine in the amount of \$50.00 per day of continuing violation, commencing five (5) days after any decision of the Board of Directors that a violation has occurred. Said five (5) days shall be allowed for the Violator to cease the violation. Said fine shall continue until the violation has been cured or \$5,000.00 accumulated, whichever calculated amount is less.

(b) If the accumulated fine is not paid within twenty (20) days after written demand to the violator by the Board of Directors, the Whispering Pines Villas Property Owners' Asso., Inc. shall file a lien against the violator's villa in the Public Records of Citrus County and shall take any other action provided by the laws of the State of Florida.

(c) If the violator is a tenant, the owner of the villa shall be notified of the violation by Certified mail in the United States and Registered mail elsewhere that their tenant is in violation.

8. Quorum requirements shall be met for all procedures hereunder and all Board members shall receive written notice of the session concerning alleged violators.
